
SNMP Quick Configuration Guide

1. Connect a Hub and a PC as shown in the diagram below. Power on the PC, Hub and make sure the PC is running Windows.




- 2. Make sure the .NETpower card is powered on.
- 3. Insert the .NETpower management CD-ROM into a CD-ROM drive.
